

Engerix B (VHB): Hepatitis-preventing vaccine

What is it?

Engerix is a monovalent vaccine that prevents Hepatitis B virus infection in non-immune people.

How does it work?

It acts by forcing the body to produce its own defenses (antibodies) against this disease. About 95-99% of people develop protective antibodies after vaccination.

When is it administered?

According to the national vaccination program:

- 1st dose - after birth, during hospital stay, in the right thigh;
- 2nd dose - at two months of life, in the health care center;
- 3rd dose - at six months of life, in the health care center.

What should I do after vaccination?

No specific precautions need.

Note: When you go to the health unit, you must have the following essential documents with you
- citizen card, individual child and adolescent health bulletin.



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
